We often use the **Present Continuous tense** in English. It is very different from the **Present Simple** tense, both in structure and in use.

**PRESENT CONTINUOUS**  
We are singing

How do we make the Present Continuous tense?

The structure of the Present Continuous tense is:

subject	+	auxiliary <i>be</i>	+	main verb
		conjugated in Present Simple		
		<b>am, are, is</b>		<b>present participle (-ing)</b>

The auxiliary verb (be) is conjugated in the Present Simple: *am, are, is*

The main verb is invariable in present participle form: *-ing*

For negative sentences we insert **not** between the auxiliary verb and the




