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Welcome to the Spring Semester of English TP! This course is meant to increase your proficiency in oral expression and listening comprehension, while applying your skills to practical situations. The objectives of these classes are to improve listening comprehension and oral expression, as well as using English in real life scenarios. Speaking is a requirement in these classes so please come prepared!

### **Evaluations**

We will have two evaluations, taken in class, both recorded out of 20 points. The first will be halfway through the course, on the fourth week of the course, and the second will be in our last class session. Date changes are possible if timetables change. You have been formally notified of the exam dates both verbally and in writing by the first day of class.

The first evaluation will be a speaking evaluation and will be out of 20 points. The second evaluation will be an oral evaluation and will also be out of 20 points. This will be in the last week of class.
