Working in groups of 2-4 people, you will need to create a movie trailer. This can be for a movie that already exists or one that you have invented. Each person in the group is expected to speak in the trailer and you will be graded as a group for your use of English. This is an opportunity to be creative, and you will be graded on this (meaning you can't copy a trailer that already exists). You will also be graded on the content of your video - does it present the film well and does it include the necessary details. Finally, you will be graded on the quality of your trailer and on your English pronunciation. Your trailer should be between 1-2 minutes.
